

OPCAT inspection in the Holding Facility of Fejér County Police Headquarters

On October 19, 2017 the staff members of the Commissioner for Fundamental Rights performing the tasks of the OPCAT National Preventive Mechanism paid an unannounced visit to the Holding Facility of Fejér County Police Headquarters.



The purpose of the visit was the examination of the treatment and the alimentation of the detainees. The members of the visiting delegation observed the premises of the holding facility, they inspected the relevant documents and conducted interviews with the detainees, the governor of the holding facility and the officer of the guard in charge and some of the staff members.
