

OPCAT visit
to the Keszthely Police Station
January 21, 2021

On January 21, 2021 the Commissioner for Fundamental Rights of Hungary, performing the tasks of the National Preventive Mechanism and his colleagues paid a visit to the Keszthely Police Station.



The purpose of the visit was to check the execution of the measures taken to prevent the spread of the coronavirus infection (COVID-19) and to remedy the harmful effects of the pandemic. The visiting group inspected the custody unit and other premises of the police station, verified the disinfection methods and safety gears used in order to protect the policemen in duty and the detainees. The visiting team conducted interviews with members of the management and the staff, reviewed the relevant documentation and the vehicle used for the transportation of the detainees.
